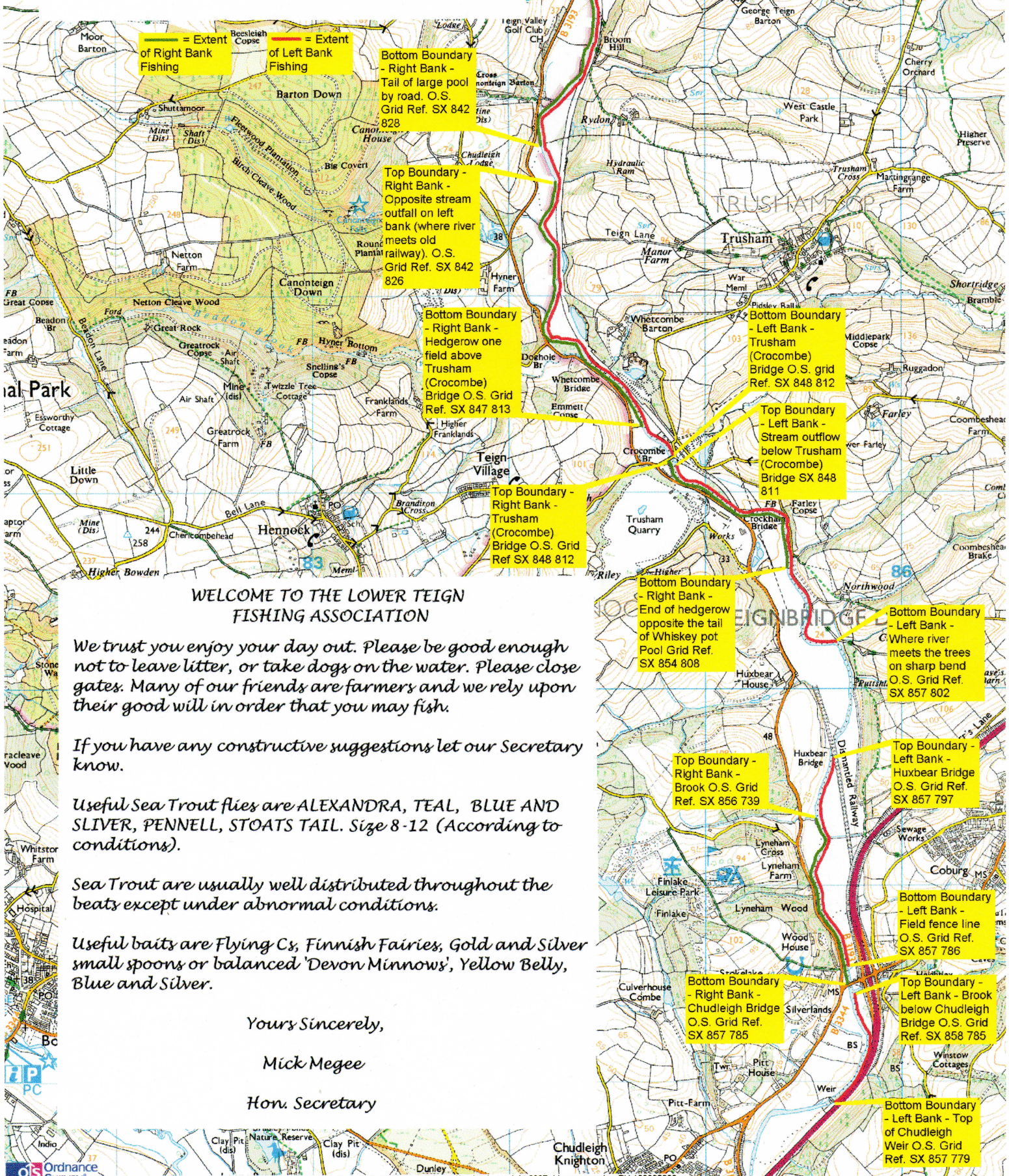


Lower Teign Fishing Association Day Ticket Map Beat 2

Useful baits are Flying Cs, Finnish Fairies, Gold and Silver small spoons or balanced 'Devon Minnows', Yellow Belly, Blue and Silver.
