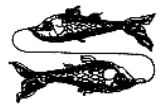

**Spreading the cost:** If your total fee is over £50 you can spread the cost by paying with 3 cheques, 2 of which are post-dated. Divide your total fee by 3 and send 3 cheques, eg adult with key (£96.50) = one £32.50 cheque dated today and two £32 cheques dated one and two months in the future, eg today's cheque = 18<sup>th</sup> Jan and post dated cheques = 18<sup>th</sup> Feb and 18<sup>th</sup> Mar. **(All cheques must be sent with this form).**

## Membership form for the 2024-25 season

Annual membership runs from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March and allows the use of two rods on:

**11 stillwaters** (no close season unless otherwise stated)

Bog Grove, Great Totham	5am to 10pm
Brick Kiln Pond, Inworth	5am to 10pm
Heron Hall, Tolleshunt Major	5am to 10pm
Little London Reservoir, Goldhanger	5am to 10pm
Railway Pond, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Rook Hall 1, 2 & 3, Heybridge	Dawn to dusk (closed 1 <sup>st</sup> October – 31 <sup>st</sup> January)
Slough House Farm, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Slough House West, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Totham Pit, Great Totham	5am to 10pm

**14 miles of river and canal** (close season 15<sup>th</sup> March to 15<sup>th</sup> June inclusive)

Chelmer & Blackwater Canal from Chelmsford to Heybridge Basin	No time restrictions
River Blackwater, Wickham Bishops	5am to 10pm

**NIGHT PERMIT (limited to 140 members)**

**For an additional £86** you can also night fish between 10pm and 5am at:

- Totham Pit all year round
  - Slough House Farm all year round \*
  - Little London Reservoir all year round
  - Bog Grove between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 30<sup>th</sup> April
- and use 3 rods between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 31<sup>st</sup> March on all venues.

\* The maximum length of a session on Slough House Farm is 3 days / 2 nights followed by a 24 hour break. All other venues listed are 4 days / 3 nights followed by a 24 hour break.

Night permits are only available to members who have a clean record with the society.

**Junior night permits** are also available priced **£43** for siblings of adult night permit holders. These must be purchased on their behalf by a current adult night permit holder from the same household. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult night permit holder from the same household while fishing between the hours of 10pm and 5am and fish in the same swim as this adult between these times. Under 10's and Non-Fishing members are not allowed on society fisheries between 10pm and 5am.

If you want to fish an extra rod in the winter but do not want to night fish (or night permits are sold out) you can pay an additional **£30 for a winter 3 rod upgrade**.

**Total membership is restricted to a maximum of 850 members.**

**Guest tickets** are available for non-members wishing to accompany a member and must be purchased in advance of fishing from the Membership Secretary, JP Tackle or from our website. Guests are not allowed to night fish.

**Day tickets** are only available on the Chelmer & Blackwater Canal and can be purchased from the Membership Secretary, JP Tackle or on the bank from a day ticket bailiff.

New members can claim the value of one guest/day ticket as discount if they subsequently decide to join the society and the ticket is submitted with their application form.
